

Why MASC?

Middletown Area Senior Citizens Inc. has been serving the needs of area seniors for over 50 years. The nonprofit organization provides a place for those 50 and older to go for nutritious meals, social activities, volunteer opportunities, health screenings, health and consumer education, creative arts, exercise and more.

MASC works with local partners to deliver home and community-based services that allow older adults to live independently in their own homes (e.g., transportation services, meals-on-wheels, adult day care, senior companions, personal care, utility and other resources, homemaker services and more).

Research data provided by US Census and the *Scripps Gerontology Center* at Miami University show that the age 60+ population in Butler and Warren counties will nearly double by 2020. The role of senior centers will continue to expand and have an increasing impact on structuring the quality of life of older adults.

The Middletown Area Senior Center was created to help meet these growing demands. With 26,000 sq. ft. situated on 11 acres, the facility is designed with current and future needs in mind.

The beautiful Center also is a tremendous community resource accommodating service organizations, business groups and others in the community requiring meeting space. In addition, there is banquet space that accommodates dances, conferences, weddings, and much, much more — drawing thousands of people each year.



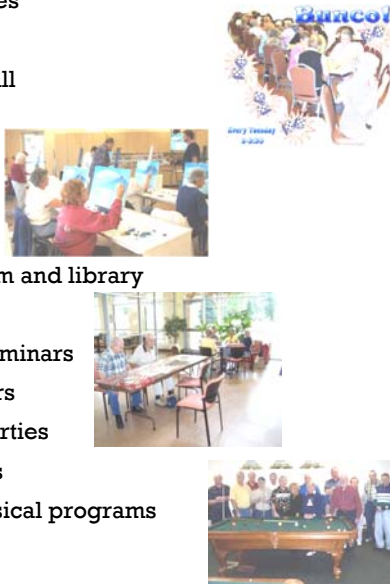
